<p>We have the RIGHT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To have our opinions listened to about things that concern us (Article 12) • To personal space and privacy (Article 16) • To protection from violence and neglect (Article 19) • To receive the care and support we need if we have a disability or specific need (Article 23) • To an adequate standard of living (Article 27) • To an education (Article 28) • To have time to relax and play (Article 31) • To be treated with respect and dignity (Article 40) 	<p>We can RESPECT each other's rights by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thinking carefully about our opinions and being willing to listen to the opinions of others • Considering other people's belongings and comfort • Being kind to others and telling an adult if we believe someone is at risk • Including everyone in our activities whenever possible, being understanding and celebrating our differences • Taking care of our school environment to allow everyone to enjoy it • Working hard and behaving in a way that does not stop anyone else from achieving their best • Allowing everyone to make their own choices, as long as their activities do not stop anyone else from relaxing or playing • Treating others the way we would want to be treated and learning from our mistakes
