Our Historical Heroes.

Florence Nightingale. Also known as 'The Lady with the lamp.'



Florence Nightingale was born in Florence, Italy on 12th May 1820.


In 1844, Florence enrolled as a nursing student in Germany. Her parents did not approve her career choice!

In October of 1853, the <u>Crimean War</u> broke out. By 1854, 18,000 soldiers had been admitted into military hospitals. At the time, there were no female nurses stationed at hospitals in the Crimea. Florence set about improving the reputation of female nurses and in improving the appallingly unsanitary and inhumane conditions.

In 1907, Florence became the first woman to receive the Order of Merit, an award given by the queen for super-special work. Sadly, Florence Nightinggle died on 13 of August 1910.

Louis Braille-1809 – 1852


Braille was a French inventor. He invented the script **braille** system, which helps blind people to read. **Braille** is read by passing one's fingers over characters made up of an arrangemen

Alexander Graham Bell

Bell was an influential scientist, engineer and inventor. He was born on March 3, 1 in Edinburgh, Scotland.

(24 November 1815 – 20 October 1842) was an English lighthouse keeper's daughter. Her participation in the rescue of survivors from the shipwrecked Forfarshire in

1838 brought her national fame.

Captain Cook.



James Cook was born on 27 October 1728 in a small village near Middlesbrough in Yorkshire.

Cook joined the British Navy and, at age 29 and was soon promoted to ship's master. In 1768, he took command of the first scientific expedition to the Pacific. In 1770, on his ship the HMB Endeavour, Cook charted New Zealand and the Great Barrier Reef of Australia. He went on to discover explore Antarctica. present-day Tonga, Easter Island, New Caledonia, the South Sandwich Islands and South Georgia.
