<u>Key Vocabulary</u>	
Island	A piece of land surrounded by sea.
Inhabited	A place or environment where people, plants and animals live.
Human Geography	Human made features that affect or change the environment or place.
Physical Geography	Natural features of a place.
Compass	an instrument containing a magnetized pointer which shows the direction of North.
Landmark	an object or feature of a landscape or town that is easily seen and recognized from a distance.
Climate	The weather conditions of a place.

Did You Know?


The Isles of Scilly are a group of islands situated South West of Cornwall. Just 5 of the islands are inhabited. (St Mary's, Bryther, St Agnes and Tresco) The islands are surrounded by the Atlantic Ocean.
